
PETITION FOR REVIEW



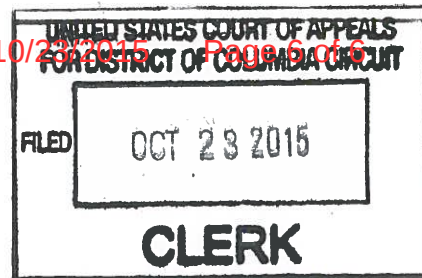
