**PETITIONERS' UNOPPOSED JOINT STIPULATION FOR
VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

Pursuant to Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure 27 and 42, Petitioners Shrimpers and Fishermen of the RGV, Sierra Club, and Save RGV from LNG respectfully move for the above-captioned petition for review to be dismissed without prejudice. As explained in the text of the petition, the petition challenges an order made by the United States Army Corps of Engineers.
