ORDER

WOLF, D.J.

January 27, 2014

For the reasons described in detail in court on January 24, 2014, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. This case is STAYED until June 1, 2015.

2. Every three months, beginning on March 31, 2014, the defendants shall provide to the court and the plaintiff a report describing: (1) the progress of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts's efforts to create and implement an updated Cape Cod areawide waste treatment management plan under Section 208 of the Clean Water Act; and (2) the nature of the Environmental Protection Agency's ongoing involvement in those efforts.

3. If the plaintiff believes that the efforts of the Commonwealth or of the Environmental Protection Agency do not comport with the representations made in the defendants' proposal for a stay (Docket No. 53) and supporting affidavits (Docket Nos. 54-56), and conferral with the defendants does not result in corrective action, the plaintiff may move to have the stay lifted. If the plaintiff files such a motion, the defendants shall reply

within fourteen days, as required by Local Rule 7.1(b)(2).

4. An extension of the stay beyond June 1, 2015 will be granted only upon a showing by the defendants of good faith, industrious efforts by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to complete and approve an updated Cape Cod areawide waste treatment management plan, and by the Environmental Protection Agency to certify that plan, as expeditiously as possible.

5. By March 31, 2014, the parties shall confer and report on whether they have agreed to settle this case.
