ORDER

Upon consideration of the petition for permission to appeal, and the emergency motion for stay pending appeal, which includes a request for administrative stay, it is

ORDERED that the district court's order filed March 22, 2021, granting the motion to remand the case to the D.C. Superior Court, be administratively stayed pending further order of the court. The purpose of this administrative stay is to give the court sufficient opportunity to consider the petition and emergency motion and should not be construed in any way as a ruling on the merits of the petition and motion. See D.C. Circuit Handbook of Practice and Internal Procedures 33 (2021). It is

FURTHER ORDERED that respondent Beyond Pesticides enter an appearance and file a combined response to the petition and emergency motion, not to exceed 10,400 words, no later than April 12, 2021. Any combined reply, not to exceed 5,200 words, is due no later than April 19, 2021.
