NOTICE RE COMPLETED SUPERSEDING BIOLOGICAL OPINION

On March 12, 2021, the Court stayed Petitioners' claims under the Endangered Species Act to allow the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service ("Service") to review and issue a new, superseding Biological Opinion ("BiOp") analyzing the potential effects of the Bureau of Land Management's programmatic Resource Management Plan for the Uncompahgre Field Office planning area on the Gunnison sage grouse and its designated critical habitat. *See* ECF No. 22. As required by the Court's March 12, 2021 Order, Federal Respondents provide notice that the Service finalized its superseding BiOp on July 26, 2021 and sent Petitioners a copy for review.
