NOTICE OF APPEAL

Southwest Energy Efficiency Project, Environment New Mexico,

Batterson (referred to as "the Appellants") hereby appeal to the New Mexico
Court of Appeals from the May 15, 2013 decision of the New Mexico
Construction Industries Commission, the New Mexico Construction
Industries Division, and Katherine Martinez, the Director of the New

Mexico Construction Industries Division (referred to as "the Appellees") adopting four New Mexico building codes. Those four building codes are: the 2011 New Mexico Electrical Code (NMAC 14.10.4), the 2009 New Mexico Energy Conservation Code (NMAC 14-7.6), the 2009 New Mexico Mechanical Code (NMAC 14.9.2), and the 2009 New Mexico Plumbing Code (NMAC 14.8.2).
