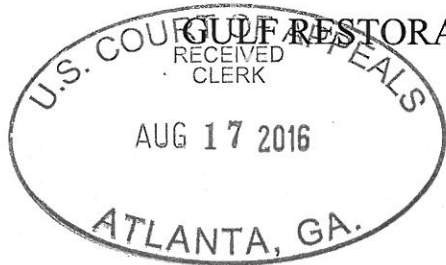



Pursuant to Section 19(d)(1) of the Natural Gas Act (NGA), 15 U.S.C. § 717r(d)(1), and Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure, Gulf Restoration Network, Flint Riverkeeper, and Sierra Club petition this Court for review of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' August 11, 2016 decision to issue five permits under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1344, to Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, and Florida Southeast Connection for the Southeast Market Pipelines Project. A copy of the agency's August 11, 2016 Record of Decision is attached to this Petition.

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
