- 4. All documents filed to date in each of the cases consolidated herein are deemed a part of the record in the Consolidated Action.
- 5. This Order shall apply to this Consolidated Action and any future actions filed in this Court relating to the subject matter of this case. When a case that properly belongs as part of the Consolidated Action is hereafter filed in this Court, this Court requests the assistance of counsel in calling to the attention of the Court the filing of any case which might properly be consolidated as part of the Consolidated Action, and counsel are to assist in assuring that counsel in subsequent actions receive notice of this Order.
- 6. Defendants shall have no obligation to respond to any complaint filed or discovery served in the above-captioned actions or any other action subsequently consolidated herewith. A consolidated amended complaint shall be filed in the Consolidated Action and shall be deemed the operative complaint or one of the complaints shall be designated as the operative complaint, and the operative complaint shall supersede all previous complaints filed in any of the Actions or any other action subsequently consolidated herewith. After filing or

designation of the operative complaint, the parties shall confer regarding the timing of the response to the operative complaint.
