		1. Petitioners have not met their burden under RCW 34.05.570(4) of
demonstrating that Ecology's denial of Petitioners' Petition to Amend WAC 173-557-050 was		
outside of Ecology's statutory authority.		
2. Petitioners have not met their burden under RCW 34.05.570(4) of		
demonstrating that Ecology's denial of Petitioners' Petition to Amend WAC 173-557-050 was		
arbitrary and capricious.		
II. CONCLUSIONS		
1. The Court concludes that WAC 173-557-050 does not exceed Ecology's		
statutory authority and that the rule is not arbitrary and capricious.		
2. The Court concludes that Ecology's denial of Petitioners' petition to amend		
WAC 173-557-050 was not outside of the agency's authority and was not arbitrary and		
capricious.		
Based upon the Court's Findings and Conclusions it is now, therefore, ORDERED:		
Petitioners' challenge to the validity of WAC 173-557-050 is denied and the matter is		
dismissed, with prejudice, each party to bear its own costs and fees.
