2	Dutch Shell plc submits the following statement: If Plaintiffs take advantage of Royal Dutch Shell	
3	plc's offer to sign and return a waiver of service of summons as provided by and subject to the	
4	provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(d), then upon the filing of such waiver the summons and complaint	
5	are deemed served on Royal Dutch Shell plc, see Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(d)(4), and the current motion to	
6	dismiss pursuant to Rule 12(b)(5) would be moot. To the extent that a waiver of service of	
7	summons ordinarily affords an extension of time to respond to the complaint, <i>see</i> Fed. R. Civ. P.	
8	4(d)(3), Royal Dutch Shell plc does not invoke any such extension or contend that it would be	
9	applicable here, where Royal Dutch Shell plc has otherwise already also filed a motion to dismiss	
10	under Rules 12(b)(2) and 12(b)(6). Accordingly, if the Rule 12(b)(5) motion is mooted by a	
11	waiver of service of summons under Rule 4(d), then the issues raised by Royal Dutch Shell plc in
