PURSUANT TO C.P.L.R.  
§ 2308(b) TO COMPEL  
COMPLIANCE WITH  
SUBPOENAS ISSUED BY THE  
ATTORNEY GENERAL**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that upon the affirmation of John Oleske made on June 19, 2018, upon the affirmation of Jonathan Zweig made on June 19, 2018, upon the accompanying memorandum of law, and upon all the papers filed by the parties to date in this matter, petitioner People of the State of New York, by Barbara D. Underwood, Attorney General of the State of New York, will move this Court located at 60 Centre Street, New York, New York, Motion Submission Part, Room 130, on the 5th day of July, 2018 at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as can be heard, for:

A) An order pursuant to C.P.L.R. § 2308(b) compelling respondent Exxon Mobil Corp. (“Exxon”) to produce, in compliance with investigatory subpoenas issued by the Attorney General: (1) the cash flow spreadsheets that the (1) company utilized in (a) making investment decisions, (b) conducting corporate planning reviews, (c) estimating company reserves and resource base quantities, and (d) conducting asset impairment evaluations for the time period January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2016 for certain of Exxon’s major projects and assets, as


specified in Exhibit A to the proposed order annexed hereto; and (2) the documents Exxon has previously provided to the Securities & Exchange Commission relating to impairment evaluations, reserves calculations, and climate change.

B) Such other and further relief as this Court deems just and proper.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that these papers have been served on you at least sixteen (16) days before the motion is scheduled to be heard. You must serve your answering papers and any notice of cross-motion with supporting papers, if any, at least seven (7) days before such time. Reply or responding affidavits shall be served at least one (1) day before such time.
