Before the Court is Federal Defendants' June 17, 2019 motion for enlargement of time for remedy briefing. On consideration of the motion and the record in this case, the Court HEREBY ORDERS that the motion is GRANTED. The parties shall file their respective remedy briefs, as described more fully in the Court's April 19, 2019 Order, ECF No. 141 at 33-34, no later than (i) fourteen days after Federal Defendants make a determination (following the Bureau of Land Management's National Environmental Policy Act analysis, now under way) as to whether preparation of a Finding of No Significant Impact is legally sufficient or if impacts of significance require preparation of an environmental impact statement, or (ii) July 22, 2019, whichever is earlier. Further, Federal Defendants' shall provide Plaintiffs' counsel with thirty days' advance notice of the conducting of any lease sale at which new coal leases or coal lease modifications are to be offered for sale, until such time as the Court issues a remedy ruling.
