
ORDER LIFTING STAY AND ADOPTING DEADLINES AS SET FORTH
IN THE PARTIES' JOINT STATUS REPORT

THIS MATTER IS BEFORE THE COURT on the Parties' Joint Status Report (Doc. 93). The Parties mutually requested a stay through April 1, 2020, which the Court granted. (*See* Doc. 91.) The Parties now advise that further litigation is necessary to resolve the dispute between them. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS the stay in this matter lifted**.

The Court **FURTHER ORDERS** that the Parties adhere to the deadlines below, subject to extension by mutual agreement. If the Parties agree to extend deadlines, they should advise the Court per D.N.M.LR-Civ. 7.4(a).

- May 1, 2020: Plaintiffs' Amended Petition for Review of Agency Action;
- May 15, 2020: Federal Defendants and Intervenors' Answers or other Responsive Pleadings;
- June 1, 2020: Parties' Joint Case Management Plan with proposed schedules for further proceedings, production of the administrative record, and briefing. The Parties should note that the Court will not entertain proposed hearing dates and will set this matter for hearing when the Court deems appropriate.
