Pursuant to D.C.Colo.LCivR 3.2, Plaintiffs submit this Notice of Related Case. The above-captioned case is related to *WildEarth Guardians v Bernhardt*, Civ. No 1:19-cv-01920-RBJ, as they both involve the same plaintiffs, the West Elk coal mine and its expansion, and air pollution from the mine, including methane emissions. In *WildEarth Guardians v Bernhardt*, the court ordered the challenged agency decision remanded to the federal agency so it can, as part of its mine approval, consider a flaring option for controlling the mine's emissions of methane and other volatile organic compounds and assess how the mine's methane emissions contribute to climate change. The present case involves permitting of those air emissions under the Clean Air Act.
