Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-3(b), Plaintiffs¹ hereby submit this statement in response to the motion for enlargement of time/stay proceeding filed by Defendants United States
Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Acting EPA Administrator Jane Nishida, the United
States Army Corps of Engineers, and Senior Official Performing the Duties of Assistant Secretary
of the Army for Civil Works Vance F. Stewart, III (collectively, the Agencies) on February 10,
2021. ECF No. 221. The motion seeks an enlargement of time for all existing calendar deadlines
by at least 75 days along with a 60-day stay of litigation to allow the Agencies time to review the

Navigable Waters Protection Rule: Definition of "Waters of the United States," 85 Fed. Reg.
22,250 (Apr. 21, 2020) (2020 Rule) pursuant to President Biden's Executive Order 13990, 86
Fed. Reg. 7037 (Jan. 25, 2021), and determine whether the 2020 Rule should be maintained,
modified, or otherwise reconsidered.

As indicated in the Agencies' motion, Plaintiffs generally agree that a limited stay and

As indicated in the Agencies' motion, Plaintiffs generally agree that a limited stay and enlargement of the deadlines in this matter are appropriate to give the Agencies an opportunity to comply with Executive Order 13990 and reevaluate both the 2020 Rule and their litigation position. Given the recent change in federal administration, a pause in the proceedings can also help minimize unnecessary expenditure of resources by the parties or the Court. To ensure that the Agencies' review of the 2020 Rule proceeds in a timely manner and to allow the parties and the Court to adequately prepare to resume litigation, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court grant the motion and also require in its order that the Agencies: 1) meet and confer with Plaintiffs regarding the status of the Agencies' review of the 2020 Rule at least 14 days before the date on which the stay of the litigation is set to expire, and 2) file a status report at least seven (7) days before the date on which the stay of the litigation is set to expire to inform the Court about the status of the Agencies' review of the 2020 Rule and plans by any party to seek further stay of the litigation or enlargement of deadlines.
