I am counsel for Exxon Mobil Corporation and ExxonMobil Oil Corporation and write on behalf of all appellants to provide the Court with an update regarding a similar appeal being litigated in the Fourth Circuit. After the Supreme Court issued its decision in *BP p.l.c.* v. *Mayor & City Council of Baltimore*, 141 S. Ct. 1532 (2021), the Court remanded the case to the Fourth Circuit for the court to decide whether the climate-change claims at issue in that case were removable on any ground other than the federal-officer ground. *See id.* at 1543. The Fourth Circuit authorized supplemental briefing after remand and has now tentatively scheduled oral argument for December 6-10, 2021. *See* Order, No. 19-1644 (Oct. 8, 2021) (Dkt. 225).

The appeals in BP and this case present similar legal issues and are in a similar procedural posture. In accordance with appellants' prior requests, appellants believe that oral argument would assist the Court in resolving the remaining legal issues in this appeal and respectfully ask that oral argument be scheduled at the Court's earliest convenience.
