## ORDER

Upon consideration of the motion of intervenor states to continue holding case in abeyance, the state and local government petitioners' motion to govern, and respondents' motion to govern, it is

**ORDERED** that these consolidated cases remain in abeyance pending further order of the court. The government is directed to file status reports on the Environmental Protection Agency's review of the challenged agency action at 90-day intervals beginning 90 days from the date of this order, and to notify the court and the parties within 7 days of any agency action resulting from the review or of a determination that no action will be taken. The parties are directed to file motions to govern future proceedings within 30 days of that notification.
