**JOINT STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE**

Under the Parties' Settlement Agreement (ECF No. 63-1), the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") agreed to review the leasing decisions challenged in this action and, on or before August 1, 2022, either issue a new decision on the leases or determine that additional National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA") analysis was necessary before BLM could reach a new decision. On August 1, 2022, BLM issued new decisions for the challenged leases. Therefore, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, Plaintiffs Diné Citizens Against Ruining Our Environment, San Juan Citizens Alliance, WildEarth Guardians, and the Sierra Club; Federal Defendants BLM, Debra Haaland in her official capacity as Secretary of the Interior, Tracy Stone-Manning in her official capacity as Director of BLM, and Melanie Barnes in her official capacity as BLM New Mexico State Director; and Defendant-Intervenor EOG Resources, Inc., hereby stipulate to the dismissal of this action with prejudice under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).
