



7. That Government's role in dealing with disaster is disaster preparedness before the incident and management after the incident which has been duly executed by setting up a department in the Office of the Prime Minister to handle matters of disaster to which available resources allocated, coordination with districts and parish chiefs, providing tools such as mega phones to chiefs, conducting early warning for persons to vacate disaster prone areas, sensitising persons on signs of likely incident and offering assistance to victims.
8. That the applicants are not entitled to any compensation claimed, the resettlement plan is ex gratia, can only be executed when resources are available, the applicants have not provided any proof that they are entitled to the same nor any basis for being given priority.
9. That this application is superfluous as against the respondents and it is just and proper that this application be dismissed with costs.
10. I swear this affidavit in Reply to oppose Miscellaneous Application No. 24 of 2020 and the Remedies it seeks.
