### THE COURT NOTES:

A. The parties have agreed these orders in an endeavour to avoid the need for general discovery.

### THE COURT ORDERS BY CONSENT THAT:

#### Online file

- 1. There is to be established an online file in relation to this proceeding, with the parties to be consulted each time before further material is added to the online file.
- 2. The Statement of Claim and Defence in this proceeding, the transcript of the case management hearing held on 17 March 2022, and a copy of these orders are to be available on the online file.

## **Concise Statement and Response**

3. By 4:00pm on 31 March 2022, the Applicants are to file a Concise Statement in the proceeding, in accordance with paragraph 6.10 of the Court's **Central Practice Note** (National Court Framework and Case Management (CPN-1) 20 December 2019).



- 4. By 4:00pm on 14 April 2022, the Respondent is to file a Concise Response in the proceeding, in accordance with paragraph 6.10 of the Central Practice Note (as applicable).
- 5. The Concise Statement and Concise Response are to be added to the online file after filing.

## **Discovery**

- 6. By 4:00pm on 14 April 2022, the Applicants are to provide to the Respondent their proposed discovery categories by reference to the issues in dispute between the parties.
- 7. By 4:00pm on 26 May 2022, the parties are to endeavour to agree upon discovery categories.
- 8. Any discovery issues which are unable to be agreed by 4:00pm on 26 May 2022 are referred to mediation before Judicial Registrar Stride at a date and time to be confirmed, with such mediation to be completed by 23 June 2022.

### **Trial**

9. The proceeding is listed for trial commencing on Tuesday 6 June 2023, at a location to be determined by further order, with an estimate of four weeks.

## Other

- 10. The proceeding is to be listed for a further judicial case management hearing in the week commencing 27 June 2022, on a date convenient to the Court and the parties in that week.
- 11. By 4:00pm on 24 June 2022, the parties are to file a joint progress report for the purposes of the case management hearing, addressing:
  - a. the progress of discovery;
  - b. proposed dates on which initial discovery will be completed;
  - c. any issues related to discovery that the parties are aware are likely to require judicial determination, and a proposed timetable for that determination;
  - d. proposals for the opt-out process;
  - e. whether any amendments to the pleadings are proposed, and a proposed timetable for those amended pleadings to be filed;
  - f. proposals for the location for the trial in June 2023;
  - g. proposals for the timing of the filing of lay and expert evidence; and
  - h. any other matters either party wishes to raise.
